Please refer to the structure and formatting guidelines below before submitting articles for Architecture Time Space & People:

Articles should start with an introduction, followed by a clear body, and conclude with a bibliography and references. The minimum text content should be 1200 words, and the maximum should be 1800 words.

Title or Headline:

Pick an engaging short headline to pique the interest of the reader and summarize or preview the article.

Tagline:

An optional single sentence tagline to support the title and make it cohesive with the body of the article.

Introduction:

The article should begin with an introduction, presenting the idea or concept and accounting for approximately 10% of the total word count.

Body:

The body can comprise up to six paragraphs and include details, explanations, statistics and any other supporting descriptive text.

References:

At the end of the article, the author should provide a complete bibliography with references. Provide appropriate credits and sources for all photographs, drawings and illustrations with usage rights.

Images, Drawings and Illustrations:

The article should be supported by high-resolution (300 dpi) images or photographs attached separately for reference. Suitable captions should accompany all images.

Submission:

The text should be formatted to Calibri, font size 12 with 1.0 spacing and can be mailed to us directly as a Word document.

Author Details:

Please send us articles with your complete postal address, telephone number and current work profile. Details of co-authors, if any, should also be included.
