ANNOUNCEMENT OF NATA 2023 FIRST TEST RESULTS

The Council of Architecture, an autonomous statutory authority of Ministry of Education, Government of India, successfully conducted First Test of NATA 2023 (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) on April 21, 2023, for admission to First Year of 5-year B.Arch. Degree Course at architectural institutions throughout the country. The Test is conducted online thrice a year in two sessions.

The First Test was conducted on 21st April, 2023 at 89 centres in the country and 08 international centres. This was a computer-based Test conducted at the Test centres in two sessions – 1st session from 10.00 am to 01.00 pm and 2nd session from 2.30 pm to 05.30 pm.

The Council is pleased to announce the Results of the NATA 2023 First Test which has been declared today on April 30, 2023. Out of 10140 candidates appearing in the Test, a total of 9611 (i.e. 94.78%) have qualified the Test. The highest score obtained in NATA First Test is 161. The candidates may download their results from NATA 2023 website www.nata.in.

In case any student(s) could not appear in the first test or could not do well due any reason, he/she may apply for the Second and third Tests scheduled to be held on 3rd June and 9th July, 2023 respectively.

It may also be clarified that in case a candidate appears for 2 Tests, best of 2 scores shall be taken as the valid score and in the case of 3 attempts, the average of the 2 best scores shall be taken as valid score. Accordingly, interested candidates may register themselves for NATA Second and Third examination at the earliest. For further information, please refer to NATA website www.nata.in.
