ANNOUNCEMENT OF NATA 2023 SECOND TEST RESULT

The Council of Architecture, an autonomous statutory authority of Ministry of Education, Government of India, successfully conducted Second Test of NATA 2023 (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) on June 3, 2023, for admission to First Year of 5-year B.Arch. Degree Course at architectural institutions throughout the country. The Test is conducted online thrice a year in two sessions.

The Second Test of NATA was conducted by the Council at 102 centres in the country and 08 international centres as a computer-based Test in two sessions – 1st session from 10.00 am to 01.00 pm and 2nd session from 2.30 pm to 05.30 pm.

The Council is pleased to announce the Results of the NATA 2023 Second Test which has been declared today on June 13, 2023. Out of 13932 candidates appearing in the Test, a total of 12808 (i.e. 91.93%) have qualified the Test. The highest score obtained in NATA is 164. The candidates may download their results from NATA 2023 website www.nata.in.

In case any student(s) could not appear in the Second test or could not do well due any reason, he/she may apply for the Third Test scheduled to be held on July 9, 2023 respectively.

I would like to mention that in case a candidate appears for 2 Tests, best of 2 scores shall be taken as the valid score and in the case of 3 attempts, the average of the 2 best scores shall be taken as valid score. Accordingly, interested candidates may register themselves for NATA Third examination at the earliest. For further information, please refer to NATA website www.nata.in.
