Subject: Implementation of Anti-Ragging measures in institution-reg.

Dear Sir/Madam.

It is brought to the notice of all approved Institutions, student and other various stakeholders that ragging is a criminal offence and COA has adopted the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Architectural Institutions, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging.

The above Regulations are mandatory and applies to Institutions. Therefore, all the Institutions should take necessary steps for its proper implementation such as:

- Constitution of Anti-Raging Committee and Anti-Raging Squad.
- Obtaining Undertakings at the time of admission and at the time of allotment of Hostel.
- Dedicated cadre of Warden(s) and regular visits to Hostels.
- Creating awareness through regular meetings with students.
- Appointing Professional Counselor(s) for Freshers.
- Erection of Poster/Banners displaying provisions of law, punishments etc.

Any violation of these Regulations as citied above by an Architectural Institution or an instance wherein any Institutions fails to take adequate steps of prevent ragging or fails to act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators for incident of ragging suitably, the COA shall take appropriate legal action against such erring Institution(s).

As the new academic session is going to begin soon, the Council solicits your full cooperation and request you to take all steps to prevent Ragging in the interest of students and the Institution.
