Sub: Extension of last date for admission to B.Arch. course at architectural institutions in the country for the academic session 2020-2021 - regarding.

Dear Sir,

I am directed to state that the Council has been receiving requests from institutions and admission authorities of several states and UTs, for extension of the last date for admission to 5-year B.Arch. degree course at institutions in the respective states/UTs, for the academic session 2020-2021, since the admission process, counselling as well as commencement of classes for B.Arch. have been delayed due to prevailing situation in view of Covid-19.

In this regard, I have to inform you that the competent authority of the Council of Architecture, upon consideration of these requests, has decided to extend the last date for completing the process of admissions in B.Arch. course in the states/UTs in the country by **December 31**, **2020** for the academic session 2020-2021, as a special case, due to the extraordinary Covid-19 Pandemic situation.

It may be mentioned that no further extension in the date shall be considered by the Council and in case any admission authority/ institution makes admission in the course after 31.12.2020, the students being admitted may not be considered for issuance of enrolment numbers by the Council.

The universities/ institutions shall be required to arrange for extra classes, as may be needed, in order to ensure that the B.Arch. course is imparted as per the Norms, Guidelines and directives issued by the Council. The same are available at the website (www.coa.gov.in) of the Council.

In view of the above, you are requested to kindly direct the concerned to ensure that the admission deadline for B.Arch. course, as approved by the Council, are adhered to by all admission authorities and institutions imparting Architecture degree course in your states/UTs.
