Subject: Clarification on experience for faculty members who have passed 3-year M.Arch. (Executive) degree course approved by the Council - reg.

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the Council of Architecture has approved 3-year M.Arch. (Executive) degree course at some architectural institutions of the country for the benefit of architects/faculty members who can pursue the course along with their employment/practice.

The Council has been lately receiving queries and requests from faculty members of Architecture who have passed 3-year Executive M.Arch. degree course approved by the Council, for not deducting a period of 3 years from teaching experience as their entire 3 years' teaching responsibilities during pursuing PG Executive course are not being considered or counted at institutions/universities for the purpose of recruitment/promotion.

The Executive Committee at its 235<sup>th</sup> meeting had deliberated the matter at length and decided that the experience of those faculty members who have undergone 3-year M.Arch. (Executive) course approved by the Council would be counted as 2 years in case they were in practice or in teaching.

In view of the above, the institutions, universities and competent authorities are requested to kindly consider and count 2 years of experience (out of total 3 years) in total experience for those faculty members who have passed 3-year M.Arch. (Executive) course, duly approved by the Council and were in practice or teaching during the said course.
