TO HEADS OF ALL ARCHITECTURAL INSTITUTIONS IMPARTING RECOGNISED QUALIFICATIONS IN INDIA.

Subject: Conduct of Inspections by the Inspectors of the Council of Architecturereg.

Dear Sir/ Madam.

I am directed to state that the Council of Architecture is a statutory authority set up under the Architects Act, 1972 to regulate architectural education and profession in the country. All architectural institutions imparting recognized architectural qualifications are required to maintain the minimum standards laid down by the Council of Architecture.

In terms of the provisions of the Architects Act, 1972, the Council is required to inspect institutions to ascertain sufficiency of standards maintained by the Institutions and to grant approval/ continuation of approval or otherwise for imparting of architectural education qualifications.

All the Institutions are hereby advised not to gratify any Inspector/ Expert of the Council visiting their institution in any manner whatsoever. Strict action shall be initiated against any Institution found guilty of indulging in such practices.

Further, in case any Inspector/ Expert of the Committee asks for any such gratification, the same may be brought to the notice of the Council of Architecture.
