Subject: Implementation of Anti Ragging Measures in your Institution -reg.

Sir/ Madam,

This is in continuation of Council's letter dated 14.11.2018 requesting your goodself to strictly implement the Anti-Ragging measures in your Institution.

It is once again brought to your kind notice that the every institution imparting Higher Education in the country is required to implement the Anti-Ragging Measures in the Institution for safety of students and providing and healthy teaching and learning environment.

The UGC Regulations define 'Ragging' as under:

Any act of Physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground or colour, race, religion, case, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

You are, therefore, requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging Workshops, updating all websites with Nodal Officers details, etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/ brochures shall be ensured.

Surprise inspection of hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreation rooms, toilets, bus-stand and any other measure which would augur well in preventing / quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior/ incident shall be stopped.
