

## **JUDGMENT**

Aggrieved by the order of the learned Single Judge in allowing the writ petitions filed by the respondent — Institution holding that that the approval granted by the council of Architecture is sufficient and that the institution need not seek approval from AICTE and that AICTE has no role to play with regard to the matter of admission and other aspects insofar as architecture course, the present appeals are filed.


2. Learned Single Judge while allowing the writ petition has relied upon the judgment of the Bombay High Court upholding

the power of Council of Architecture under the provisions contained in the Architects Act, 1972.

- 3. Heard the learned counsel for both parties.
- 4. It is brought to our notice that the questions involved in these appeals are now pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Judgment rendered by the Bombay High Court has been challenged by the appellant herein before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 5. Sri Srinivasa Rao, learned counsel appearing for the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent Institution submits that both parties are bound by the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court to be rendered in the matter taken by the appellant herein to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. He further submits that in case the appeal filed by the appellant herein is held in its favour by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, then the respondent will be bound by the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and in such an event, the respondent shall redeposit the amount before the appellant herein. Therefore, he requests this Court to dispose of these appeals holding that the decision to be rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court shall bind both parties

6. Aforesaid fact is not disputed by the appellants' counsel. In view of the same, these appeals are disposed of holding that the order of the Single Judge passed in writ petitions would be subject to the out come of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter now pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the judgment of the Bombay High Court.

Accordingly, these appeals are disposed of.
